At a business meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Loudoun County, Virginia, held in the County Government Center, Board of Supervisors' Meeting Room, 1 Harrison Street, S.E., Leesburg, Virginia, on Thursday, October 20, 2016 at 5:00 p.m.

IN RE: ZOAM 2014-0006, Noise Standards (Countywide)

Supervisor Volpe moved that the Board of Supervisors approve ZOAM 2014-0006, Noise Standards, as provided in Attachment 1 to the October 20, 2016, Board of Supervisors Business Meeting Action Item Addendum, with an effective date of January 1, 2017.

Seconded by Vice Chairman Buona.

Supervisor Volpe accepted Supervisor Meyer's Friendly Amendment to change 5-1507 Noise Standards, F.-Exemptions, #4 to state: Sounds created by generators and accessory equipment operating during an emergency or at the request of a utility, and the testing of said generators and accessory equipment.

Supervisor Volpe did not accept Supervisor Meyer's Friendly Amendment to change C(2) to state: Emergency is any occurrence or set of circumstances involving actual or imminent physical trauma, MATERIAL and PHYSICAL property damage or loss of electric or phone services, which require immediate action.

Supervisor Meyer moved an Amendment to the Motion that C(2) be revised to state: Emergency is any occurrence or set of circumstances involving actual or imminent physical trauma, MATERIAL and PHYSICAL property damage or loss of electric or phone services, which require immediate action.

Seconded by Chairman Randall.

Voting on the FAILED Amendment to the Motion: Supervisor Meyer – Yes; Supervisors Buffington, Buona, Higgins, Letourneau, Randall, Saines, Umstattd, and Volpe – No.

Supervisor Umstattd moved an Amendment to the Motion that Table 5-1507(E), Residential and Rural Economy Uses category be amended to a 45 Maximum A-Weighted Sound Level (decibels) in ZOAM-2014-0006, Noise Standards.

The Motion died due to lack of a second.

Voting on the Main Motion, as Amended: Supervisors Buffington, Buona, Higgins, Letourneau, Randall, Saines, and Volpe – Yes; Supervisors Meyer and Umstattd – No.

Chairman Randall moved that the Board of Supervisors direct staff to research issues related to outdoor recreation amplified noise and report back to Transportation Land Use Committee with options as part of the rural uses and performance standards rural package two.

Seconded by Supervisor Volpe.

Chairman Randall withdrew her Motion.
