

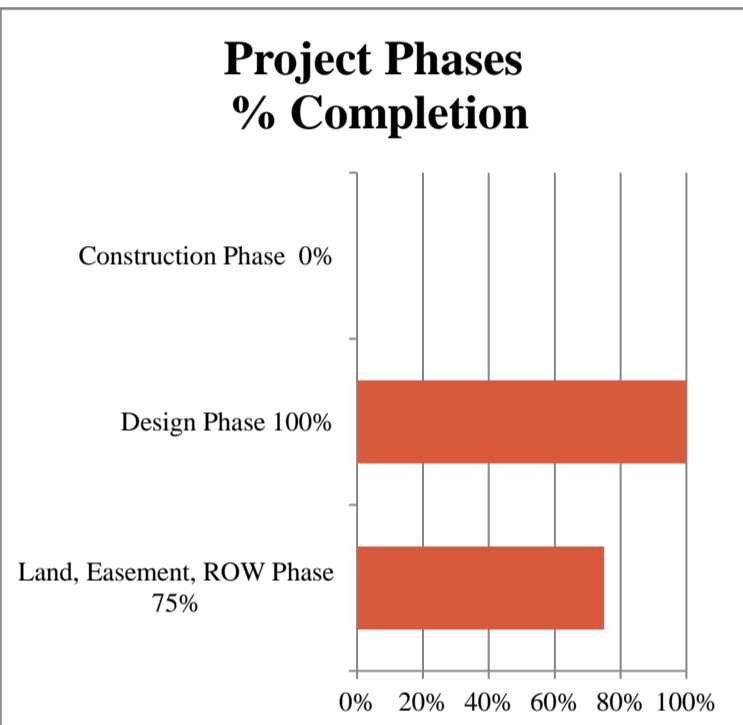

Project Status Update:

The roadway design plans were approved by B&D on December 9, 2019. In this quarter, the Town Attorney for Purcellville provided the Corporate Boundary Line Adjustment Agreement (Agreement) to the County Attorney's Office in August 2020. Once signed by both jurisdictions, the Agreement will be submitted to the Circuit Court for approval. The remaining plats that are dependent on the completion of the Corporate Boundary Line Adjustment were submitted to the Town of Purcellville in August 2020 for review. In the next quarter, the Corporate Boundary Line Adjustment process, plat coordination with the Town, and ROW acquisition will continue.
