Landam County to wit

Memorandum that upon this 24th day
of Sept^r 1816 Joseph Laycock, Arnold Murphy (and Hubert
Hurdan a ^{free} man of colour) came before the subscribers a justice
of the peace for the county aforesaid and each of them of his
proper person acknowledged himself indebted to Wilson
C. Nicolas Esq^r governor of Virginia and his successors
in the sum of one hundred Dollars to be levied on his goods
Chattels &c. respectively to the use of the said Common wealth
upon Condition that each of them do personally appear before
the common wealth justices of the peace for said County of Landam
on the 4th of October at a Court by them to be held at the court
=house of the said County for the examination of (William
Winkfield a free man of colour) touching a charge with
stealing a certain negro slave with a knife. and do then
and there on behalf of the common wealth give such evidence
as he knoweth against the said William Winkfield
concerning the matters where with he is charged and that
within he nor either of them do depart without leave of
said Court then this recognizance to be void or else to remain
in full force and virtue
