Whereas William Lightfoot hath given
information upon oath, to me John
McCormick, a Justice of the Peace for the
county aforesaid that on the day of
last past, at the county aforesaid a certain
Slighter Smith of did maliciously
shoot a certain Henry Hopkins a
man of colour, in the thigh with an
intention of disfiguring, disabling
killing the said Henry ^{Hopkins} ~~Holliman~~.
There are therefore in the Name of the
commonwealth, to require you to
apprehend the said Slighter Smith
and bring him before me, or some
other Justice of the Peace for the county
aforesaid to answer the premises,
and for this to be dealt with according
to law. Given under my hand and
seal this 21st day of March 1819.
