Be it remembered that on the 11 day of November  
one thousand Eight hundred & Eighteen, Richard Winters and  
James Winters, (Freemen of Colour) of the County of Loudoun came  
before me Samuel Murrey one of the commonwealths Justices  
of the peace for the County aforesaid & Acknowledged themselves to owe  
Jas P Preston - Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia  
and his successors to wit Richard Winters the Sum of forty Dollars  
and the said James Winters the Sum of forty Dollars Current Money  
of Virginia to be respectively Levied and made of their several  
Goods and Chattels lands and Tenements to the Use of the common-  
wealth aforesaid if he the said Richard Winters shall fail in  
performing the Condition underwritten ~~of the present~~

The Condition of this recognizance is such that if the  
above bound Richard Winters shall personally appear on  
the 17 day of Nov<sup>r</sup>: 1818 at the Court house at an Examining Court  
to be held there for the County of Loudoun and to do & receive what  
shall then and there be enjoined him by the said Courts and in the  
mean time shall keep the peace and be of good behaviour  
towards the commonwealth & all its Citizens then the above recog-  
nizance shall be void, or else remain in full force
