Virginia tenth judicial circuit:

Loudoun County to wit:

The jurors for the Superior Court of law for the County of Loudoun being one of the Counties composing the tenth judicial circuit for the State of Virginia being impaneled, sworn, affirmed and charged on their oaths and affirmations for that Sampson Richards late of the parish of Shelburne and County aforesaid to labor did on the twentieth day of November in the year eighteen hundred and twenty one at the parish and County aforesaid and within the jurisdiction of this Court with force and arms unlawfully stab a negro man slave named Daniel Goings the property of ~~James Greenwell~~ ^{James Greenwell} in the left side of him the said ~~negro~~ ^{negro} then and there being, and him the said within ten lion to maim, disfigure, disable, or kill him the said Daniel Goings contrary to the Act of the General Assembly in such cases provided, to the great injury of the said Daniel Goings and against the peace and dignity of the Commonwealth.

And the jurors aforesaid on their oaths and affirmations aforesaid for the present that the said Sampson Richards late of the parish of Shelburne and County aforesaid labor did on the twentieth day of November in the year eighteen hundred and twenty one at the parish and County aforesaid and within the jurisdiction of this Court with force and arms unlawfully stab a free man of color and not a slave named Daniel Goings then and there being in the left side of him the said Daniel Goings
