

Charge - Unlawful Gaming

See Free Blacks - 1823-13

Loudoun County Va.

Whereas information hath this day been made before me
and M. Edwards a Justice of the Peace for said County, ^{by Isaac Wright of 1st County of Loudoun} that Leroy
Mullion a free man of Colom hath been guilty of unlawful
gaming, by playing at dice in his own house in the Town
of Susseing, being a public place, or keeping house, in the County
aforesaid, within twelve months last past. These are therefore
to require you to summon said Leroy Mullion, forthwith
to appear before me or some other Justice of the Peace for said
County, to show cause why the penalty of \$20 should not
be levied upon him for his ^{id} offence. You be further
dealt with according to the act of Assembly in this behalf made
Given under my hand Oct. 9. 1823.
