YOU are hereby commanded that you summon *Harmah Bolen*
a free negro of the County of Loudoun

to appear before the Justices of our county court of Loudoun on the second Monday in
Nov next, at the court house thereof, to shew cause why an information
should not be filed against him, upon a presentment of the Grand Jury made against
him on the *1st* day of *June* court *1833* for *Remaining*

in the Commonwealth Contrary to Law upon
the Information of Jesse Summers Commissioner
of the Revenue

And have then there this writ. Witness CHARLES BINNS, clerk of our said court, at
the court house aforesaid, this *27th* day of *aug* 18*33* and in the
50th year of the commonwealth.
