Crime: Remaining in the commonwealth

Lonsden County to wit

Be it remembered, that on the 11th day of August in the year 1834 Titus Brown a free man of colour of said County late and John Lanney Attorney at Law of the same County personally came before me James H. Chamblin deputy for strip Buekne High Sheriff of said County and acknowledged themselves to be indebted to Littleton W. Jaywell Governor or chief Magistrate of the Commonwealth of Virginia, and his successors, that is to say, the said Titus Brown the sum of Two hundred Dollars and the said John Lanney the sum of Two hundred Dollars to be respectively levied of their lands and tenements goods and chattels, if the said Titus Brown shall make default in performance of the condition underwritten



The condition of this recognizance is such ^{whereas} that of the above named Titus Brown hath been arrested by James H. Chamblin deputy for strip Buekne High Sheriff of the County aforesaid under a Capias issued from the Clerks Office of the Circuit Superior Court of Law & Chancery for the County of Lonsden to answer an information filed against him for remaining in this State more than 12 Months after his right to freedom and contrary to Law - Now if the said Titus Brown shall personally appear before the Judge of our said Circuit Superior Court of Law & Chancery on the first day of September Term next then and there to answer to the Commonwealth for and concerning the offence aforesaid with which he stands charged before the said Court and to do and receive what by the said Court, shall then and there be ordered and adjudged and shall not depart thence without leave of the said Court then this recognizance shall be void or else remain in full force and virtue - Acknowledged before me
