Crime: Remaining in the Commonwealth

THE COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA,

TO THE SHERIFF OF LOUDOUN COUNTY, GREETING:

WE command you to summon *Peter Davis*

to appear before the Judge of our Circuit Superior Court of Law and Chancery of the county of Loudoun, at the Court-house of the said county, on the *1st* day of *September Term* 18 *33*, to show cause, if any he can, why an information should not be filed against him, upon a presentment of the Grand jury made against him in the said Court, on the *22^d* day of April 1833, for remaining in the County of Loudoun, contrary to Law

And have then there this writ. Witness WILLIAM A. POWELL, Clerk of our said Circuit Superior Court, at the Court-house aforesaid, the *12th* day of *July* 1833 and in the *58th* year of the commonwealth.

To the Sheriff of Loudoun County Meeting:
We command you that you do not omit for any liberty or
your bailiwick but that you take Peter Davis a free man
of colour of said county if he be found in your bailiwick, and
him safely keep so that you have his body before the Judge
of our circuit Superior Court of Law and Chancery for the
said county of Loudoun at the court-house thereof on the
1st day of the next term to answer an information filed
against him for remaining in this state more than 12
months after his right to freedom accrued and contrary to
Law: and have then there this writ: Witness William H.
Powell clerk of our said court at the court-house aforesaid
the 5 day of January 1835, and in the 59th year of the
Commonwealth —
