Virginia Loudoun County to wit:

Richd M Anderson attorney for the Common
wealth for the County Court of Loudoun, being
present here in Court this fourth day of June
in the year eighteen hundred and thirty

three gives the Court to understand and be informed
that when ^{the same was calculated} ~~the same~~ a free negro emancipated

since the first day of May in the year eighteen
hundred and six, and before the first day of July

in the year eighteen hundred and thirty one,
in said County, with force and arms did at the County fair

and within the jurisdiction ^{of said County} remain in said County
more than twelve months after his emancipation to wit

from the first day of July in the year eighteen hundred
and thirty one until the first day of August in the

year eighteen hundred and thirty two, without having
obtained permission of the Court to that effect; contrary to

the form of the Act of the General Assembly in such cases
provided, and against the peace and dignity of

the Commonwealth. And so the said attorney
prays the advice of the Court in the premises, and that

due process of law be awarded against the said John Crow
tee.
