to appear before the Justices of our county court of Loudoun on the second Monday in
Month next, at the court house thereof, to shew cause why an information
should not be filed against him, upon a presentment of the Grand Jury made against
him on the *1st* day of *August* court *1833* for *emanuing*

*in the aforesaid County contrary to Law by the
Information of Jesse McVeigh sworn & sent to the
Grand jury by Order of Court*

the court house aforesaid, this *26th* day of *August* 1833 and in the
50th year of the commonwealth.
