TO THE SHERIFF OF LOUDOUN COUNTY, GREETING:

YOU are hereby commanded that you summon *Peyton (a free negro)*
at Jonah Smiths)

to appear before the Justices of our county court of Loudoun on the second Monday in
Nov. next, at the court house thereof, to shew cause why an information
should not be filed against him, upon a presentment of the Grand Jury made against
him on the *10th* day of *August* court *1833* for remaining

in the aforesaid County Contrary to Law by the
Information of Jesse W. Leigh Sworn & Sent to the
Grandjury by Order of Court

And have then there this writ. Witness CHARLES BINNS, clerk of our said court, at
the court house aforesaid, this *20th* day of *August* *1833* and in the
50th year of the commonwealth.
