THE COMMONWEALTH OF VIRGINIA,

TO THE SHERIFF OF *Loudoun* COUNTY, GREETING:

YOU are hereby commanded to summon *Fielding Ayer and James Ayer*

Grand Jury
to appear before the judge of the general court on the *1st* day of the next ~~Superior~~ Court to be holden for the county of Loudoun, at the court house of said county, to testify and the truth to speak on behalf of *give evidence* against *James Paine a free Negro* said to have been *manacled since the year 1800* in a certain matter of controversy in our said court before our said judge depending and undetermined between *Justice*

and this *they* shall in no wise omit under the penalty of 100*l. each*.
And have then there this writ. Witness CHARLES BINNS, clerk of our said court, at the court house aforesaid, the *26th* day of *June* 1835 and in the *59th* year of the commonwealth.
