Loudoun County, Va

To the Keeper of the Jail of said County.

You are hereby required to receive into your Jail and Custody, and then safely keep until they are discharged by due course of Law, the body of Thomas Gault a free man of colour, charged with having feloniously taken, stolen and carried away from the possession of John S. Sullivan of said County, in the County aforesaid, a dark coloured Horse some time in the month of September last.

Given under my hand this 12th Nov 1835.

Fairfax County to wit

whereas John S. Sullivan hath this Day

complained to me a Justice of peace for said County, on oath
that A. New coloured Horse with a Dark streak down his
back was feloniously Taken Stolen & carried out of his posses-
sion, and he has just grounds to believe & does believe that the
said Horse was so feloniously Stolen Taken & carried away
by a certain Man of colour, who calls himself Thomas Gant
There are therefore to Require & Comin and you in the name
of the Commonwealth bring the said Thomas Gant before me
or some other Justice of the peace for said County, ^{together with}
with the said Horse if to be found, to answer the premises
& to be further dealt with as the Law may Require. Given
under my Hand & Seal this 9th Day of Nov. 1835
