
To the sheriff of Loudoun county Greeting
We command you to summon negro Patty an emancipated
slave late the property of Joseph Lewis dec'd to appear before the
Ludg of our ancient superior court of law and chancery of the county
of Loudoun at the court-house of said county on the 1st day of
April Term 1835, to answer an information filed agst
her upon a presentment made agst her at the Oct^r term ¹⁸³⁴ of
said court for remaining in the commonwealth more than
12 months since her emancipation viz since 1st May 1836 without
leave of court: ^{& contrary to law} And have ther ther this wit' W. Strep William
A. Powell clerk of our said ancient superior court at the court
house aforesaid this 16th day of January 1835, and in the
5th year of the commonwealth

To the Sheriff of Loudoun County Greeting:

We command you to summon Negro Patsy, an Emancipated Slave, late the property of Joseph Lewis dec^d to appear before the Judge of our Circuit Superior Court of Law and Chancery of the county of Loudoun at the Court-house of said County on the 1st day of September Term 1834, to show cause, if any she can, why an information shall not be filed against her, upon a presentment made against her at the last Term of said Court, for remaining in the Commonwealth more than 12 months since her Emancipation, viz seized 1 May 1806, without leave of Court -

And have then thus this Writ: Witness William A Powell Clerk of our said Circuit Superior Court at the Courthouse aforesaid this 22^d day of July 1834 and in the 55th year of the Commonwealth -
