Loudoun County Court

Whereas Westward Green a Negro who alleges that he is a free man & who resides in this county has failed to produce his Certificate of Registry when therunto required by me a Justice of the Peace of the Commonwealth of Virginia in & for the sd County, I do hereby command you William B. Toland a Constable of Loudoun County - forthwith to convey the sd Westward Green to the jail of the sd County & to deliver him together with this precept to the Keeper thereof. And I do hereby command you the sd Keeper to receive the sd Westward Green ~~into your~~ custody in the sd jail & him safely keep until such Certificate be produced & your fees ~~paid~~ those of the Constable of fees be paid or until he shall be otherwise discharged in due course of law
