At a term of the County Court of Loudoun held
this 13th day of August in the year 1849

Wm Banton by aforesaid sitting as a Court
Jes L Powell of oyer and terminer for the trial
G. D. Lee of Jack Norval otherwise called
Geo Abel Jack Spott a Free Negro in view
of the County aforesaid charged
that he did on the twenty fourth
day of July in the year of our
Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty
nine at the County aforesaid feloniously
and feloniously burn four
stacks of wheat of the value of four hun-
dred and twenty dollars of the property and
wheat of Levin Richards of the County aforesaid
Contrary to the form of the Act of the General
assembly in that case made and provided and
against the peace and dignity of the Common-
wealth

The said Jack Norval otherwise called
Jack Spott being led to the Bar in the Custody
of the Jailor and being ^{of the felony aforesaid} arraigned ~~and~~ in his
arraignment ~~by~~ pleaded not guilty
