Crime: remaining in the Commonwealth

The Commonwealth of Virginia.

To the Sheriff of Loudoun County. Greeting:

Whereas at a court held for the County of Loudoun at the Court-house on the 14th day of August 1849, a Jury having been impannelled and sworn the truth to speak upon the issue joined between us and Charles Ambrose late of the County aforesaid on a certain Indictment before that time found against the said Charles Ambrose for remaining in the State of Virginia contrary to Law, and having heard the evidence, upon their oath did say, that the said Charles Ambrose was guilty in manner and form as in the said Indictment against him was alleged.

~~and they were~~ Therefore we command you that you do not omit for any Liberty in your Bailiwick, but that you take the said Charles Ambrose if he be found within the same, and him safely keep so that you have his body before the Justices of our said Court at the Court-house aforesaid, on the first day of November next 1849 to shew if anything for himself he hath or knows to say, why the said Court should not then and there proceed to pronounce judgment against him according to Law; and further to do, submit to, and receive what our said Court shall then and there of him in this part, consider. And have then there this writ. Witness Charles G. Eskidge clerk of our said Court, at the Court-house this 27th day of August 1849, and in the 74th year of the Commonwealth
