The Commonwealth of Virginia,

TO THE SHERIFF OF LOUDOUN COUNTY, GREETING,

WE command you to Summon *John Mason. a free man of colour*

to appear before the Justices of our County Court of Loudoun, at the Court-House of the said County, on
the SECOND MONDAY in *November* ^{to show cause why he can why} ~~1828~~, ^{should not be} ~~to answer us upon an Information filed against him~~
upon a presentment of the Grand Jury, made against *him* at *August* Court, 1828, for
remaining in the County contrary to law upon the infor-
mation of Edward Hammet, one of our own body sworn in
open Court and sent up to us. by the Court.
