The Commonwealth of Virginia, to the Sheriff of Loudoun  
County Giving you authority Commanded be it enacted that  
you was Commanded that you take George Squires —  
if he be found within your Bailwick and him solidly keep  
so that you have his Body — before the Justices of our said County  
Court at the Court house in Leebury on the second Monday  
in June next to answer Sarah Squires a Free Negro of value  
admitted for above the price of twenty pounds amongst ten pounds  
and have then the other best witness Charles Morris Clerk of our  
said Court at the Court house at noon the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of April 1771  
and in the 1<sup>st</sup> year of the Commonwealth — Chas Morris.
