I know all men by these presents that I Reubin Triplett doth
by these presents set free and discharge Negro Cyrus
from any further service to me my heirs Exors admors or
assigns and that from this date the said Negro Cyrus
is at full liberty to act in every respect as other freemen
may do without interruption from me or any person
or persons whatsoever claiming by from or under
me. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand & seal this third day of March 1795.
