Slaves or Abolition of any person whatsoever — And
for the performance of which I bind myself my Heirs Executors
Adm^r and Assigns in the full and just sum of one hundred pounds
Sterling Money of Great Britain to the aforesaid Negroes at any
time after the term limited here by me my Heirs Executors
Adm^r or Assigns any other person claiming any Right Title
Interest in or to the said Negroes or of any part thereof
me my Heirs Executors Adm^r or Assigns so as to hinder
from the free Exercise of his Freedom without a voluntary
Act of the aforesaid Negroes own Consent In Witness whereof
I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this fourth day of November
in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and seventy five
