March the 29 1836 Loudoun County Va

This day E Ephraim Schooley personally  
appeared before me a Justice of the Peace for sd  
County and made solemn affirmation that he has  
known Amos Robinson & Margaret Robinson his sister  
from small children and that they are the  
children of Mary Robinson formerly Hulls - & formerly  
of this County free persons of Colour. Amos is five  
feet eight & 3/4 inches high with a scar on the right  
side of his chin and also on his breast and right  
fore finger besides a scar on his nose between his eyes  
and also scar lengthwise on his right middle finger  
about one inch long - his sister Margaret Robinson  
five feet five and 3/4 inches high with a scar on  
the left arm between the hand and Elbow and also  
a scar on the left eyebrow - Amos middling dark  
and between twenty one and two years of age  
Margaret his sister near the same Colour  
and between nineteen and twenty years of age
