This day Isaac Gibson personally  
appeared before me Edw<sup>d</sup> B. Grady a Justice of the Peace  
in the County aforesaid and made solemn affirmation  
that the colored girl calling herself Elizabeth Carroll,  
was the reputed daughter of Sarah Carroll a free white  
woman, and that he has good reason to believe it  
is so, inasmuch as the said Sarah Carroll brought  
the said Elizabeth when about four or five years old and  
placed her under his mother's charge, to ~~be kept~~ when  
she was to remain until free or grown, communi-  
cating the fact that she was her child given under my  
hand this 26<sup>th</sup> day of Nov<sup>r</sup> 1836
