BROWN, DANIEL VS. HARRY

AUGUSTINE LOVE

Know all men by these presents that We Three Harry ~~a free~~  
and Frances a free negro and Augustine Love of the County  
of Loudoun are held and firmly bound unto Daniel Brown  
of said County in the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars  
Current money of the United States, to whypayment well &  
truly to be made to the said Daniel Brown his heirs, Executors  
Adm<sup>r</sup>. and Assigns, We bind ourselves our heirs Executors and  
Administrators, jointly & severally firmly by these presents  
Sealed with our seals and dated this 7<sup>th</sup> day of April 1813

The Condition of the above Obligation is such that whereas  
the above bound Three Harry hath obtained a Writ of  
Superseas to a Judgment of the Court of Loudoun County  
recovered against him by the said Daniel Brown on the  
11<sup>th</sup> day of March 1813 for forty one dollar and fifty three  
cents with legal Interest thereon from the 16<sup>th</sup> day of March  
1808 unto payment and the costs. Now if the said Three  
Harry shall prosecute the said Writ with Effect or shall  
well and truly pay the Judgment aforesaid of the said  
County Court and all such damages and costs as shall  
be awarded against him by the Superior Court of Law  
for the County of Loudoun in case the Judgment aforesaid  
shall be affirmed, then the above Obligation to be void other-  
wise to remain in full force and virtue.
