This day Mary Dorey personally appeared before me John Purry Justice of the Peace for sd County and solemnly affirmed that she has known Pally Banks formerly Pally Gains from a small child and knows her to be the Daughter of Alley Gains a free woman of colour and believes sd Pally Banks to be about twenty three years of age — the said Pally Banks is about five feet three and a half inches high a rather dark Melatto with a scar on the back of her left hand and also two small scars on near the Elbo on the left arm & two scars on the right arm between the Elbo and the wrist one or two small moles in the upright cheek and a scar over the right eye

Given under my hand this 15th of February 1857
