Loudon County Court

This day Margent Hough of said County personally appeared before me and made oath, that John Farmer aged about 26 or 27 Years of age, 5 feet $8\frac{1}{4}$ inches high, Black colour, two small round scars on the inside of the left wrist, and one long one on the back of the right hand near the wrist joint, is the son of Nancy Farmer who was free at the time of the birth of said John -

also that William Farmer aged about 21 or 22 Years 5 feet $5\frac{1}{2}$ inches high, Black colour, a scar about $\frac{3}{4}$ inch long on the inside of the right wrist near the joint, a slight scar about $\frac{3}{4}$ of an inch above the right eyebrow, and a slight scar on the right cheek, & the little finger of the left hand crooked, is the son of the said Nancy Farmer who as before mentioned, was free at the time of his birth.
