William C Miller complains of
Samuel Murray, a free man of colour, in custody
&c. of a plea that he render to him the sum of
\$43.37½ cts, which he owes him and unjustly
detains from him; For that whereas, the said
Samuel Murray, heretofore to wit, on the 3^d day
of february 1857, by his certain ^{writing} obligatory, purporting
to be a single note of hand, bound himself to pay
to the said William C Miller, for value received of him,
the just and full sum of \$43.37½ cts above deman-
ded, to be paid to the said William C Miller, whenever
the same should be demanded of him the said
Samuel Murray: yet the said deft though
often requested, hath not yet paid the said sum
or any part thereof to the said pff. but to
pay the same hath hitherto wholly refused & still
refuses so to do to the damage of the said pff.
\$20 dollars and therefore he sues.
