Questions and Answers Summary

Questions	Answers
How do I provide my suggestions for the park?	Throughout the design and construction process, residents can email dtpci@loudoun.gov .
Where do I find out more information about the project and sign-up for alerts?	Visit loudoun.gov/dullessouthpark for more information about the project and sign-up for alerts under "Stay Informed".
What kinds of facilities are planned for the park?	This park is currently proposed to include a cricket pitch, inline hockey, rectangular athletic fields, a playground, restrooms, picnic pavilions, a concession stand, trails, and parking areas.
Will the park have field lighting?	Lighting is proposed for the fields, roadways and parking areas. This lighting will be designed to meet the standards required by the Loudoun County Zoning Ordinance.
Will pickleball be provided?	The adjacent Loudoun County Public School (LCPS) property has a lighted 6-court tennis facility; LCPS proposes to stripe these courts for pickleball game lines in the future. These facilities can be reserved for use by PRCS outside of LCPS events.
Can PRCS use the adjacent LCPS Facilities?	The adjacent LCPS property has a variety of existing sports facilities on their property. LCPS allows these facilities to be reserved for use by PRCS outside of LCPS events.
What will be the park's hours of operation?	The standard hours of operation for a Loudoun County park is Dawn to Dusk with the exception of lighted facilities. These parks

	are open until 11:00 p.m. on weekends, 10:00 p.m. on weekdays.
How will the park be accessed?	Primary access to the park will be from Hovatter Drive, with secondary access for emergency vehicles only through the LCPS property. A trail connection will be provided.
How will park access be controlled?	An access gate is proposed at the main park entrance on Hovatter Drive that will be closed when the park is closed. The Secondary access through the school parking lot will have collapsable bollards which will restrict access to only allow emergency vehicles.
Are there other community parks with athletic field lighting in Loudoun County?	Yes, Moorefield, Byrne’s Ridge, Brambleton West/East, Chick Ford and Ryan Bickel Field, Conklin Park, Lucketts Park, Potmac Lakes Sportsplex, Trailside Park and Edgar Tillet parks are all community parks in Loudoun County that have athletic field lighting.
What will the park be named?	The final park name is determined by the Board of Supervisors. The project is currently titled “Dulles South Community Park” to align with the project name in the Loudoun County Capital Improvement Plan .
When will the park construction be complete?	Construction is currently estimated to begin fall 2026 and to be completed summer 2028.
