At a business meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Loudoun County, Virginia, held in the County Government Center, Board of Supervisors' Meeting Room, 1 Harrison St., S.E., Leesburg, Virginia, on Tuesday, June 5, 2007 at 9:30 a.m.

IN RE: PLEASANT VIEW – HAMILTON 230KV TRANSMISSION LINE

Ms. Kurtz moved that the Board of Supervisors suspend the rules.

Seconded by Mr. Clem.

Voting on the Motion: Supervisors Burton, Clem, Delgaudio, Kurtz, Staton, Waters, and York - Yes; None – No; Supervisors Snow and Tulloch – Absent for the Vote.

Ms. Kurtz moved that the Board of Supervisors approve the following resolutions:

WHEREAS, Dominion Virginia Power currently has pending before the State Corporation Commission an application to locate a 230 kV transmission line from the Pleasant View Substation near Leesburg to a new substation near Hamilton (Case No. PUE-2005-00018); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has previously adopted positions opposing the location of this line along the W&OD Trail and urging that the line be constructed underground along any chosen route; and

WHEREAS, on January 7, 2007 the Hearing Examiner in this case recommended an overhead route which generally followed the W&OD Trail between the Town of Leesburg and Clark's Gap; and

WHEREAS, on February 21, 2007, the State Corporation Commission remanded the case to the Hearing Examiner to take additional evidence on various matters, including underground construction of the portion of the Modified D route comprising segments along or adjacent to the W&OD Trail between the Town of Leesburg and Clark's Gap; and


WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors wishes to supplement its prior position based on these developments in the proceedings to specifically address the segment of the line along or adjacent to the W&OD Trail between the Town of Leesburg and Clark's Gap; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of Loudoun County, Virginia only supports the location of the line along or adjacent to the W&OD Trail on the segment between the Town of Leesburg and Clark's Gap if the State Corporation Commission requires Dominion to install the line underground at a minimum width with the least amount of impact.
